Parent Teacher Interviews

The Parent Teacher Interview afternoon is on Monday 16 April. Appointments can be booked through the Parent Lounge Portal. We encourage parents and caregivers to make a time to meet with teachers to discuss any questions or concerns.

Return to School Date and Time

- Term Two will commence on **Tuesday 17 April** at 8.25am. Students will begin with lesson one on Day 2 as per their Student Café timetable. Please note Monday 16 April is a student free day.

General matters

- The college uses a variety of methods to communicate key information. Please regularly check any of the following to receive important information: Wednesday email, TCC Skoolbag APP, College website, emails and Facebook. Further, TCC News is accessible through many of these given sources.

Term Two Uniform Expectations

For Girls

- Please ensure their blouse and skirt are an appropriate size. Skirts must be knee length.
- Hairstyles should be conservative in nature. Hair is to be tied back in a way that allows hats to sit properly (no buns on top).

For Boys

- Wearitto has indicated that College hats for boys should arrive over the Easter break.
- Please ensure that shirts, shorts and socks are an appropriate size. Often boys who have trouble keeping shirts in and socks up do so because they no longer fit.
- The College tie is to be worn for Term Two and Three.
- As a guide, hair should be well above the collar in length, short at the front and ears clearly visible. Nothing shorter than a blade three and if hair is longer on top, it needs to be blended to the sides. No layered, ridged, lines or under-cuts are allowed.
- Facial hair: Side burns should be kept short. Facial hair needs to be shaved on a daily basis.

General Uniform points

- College hats should be clearly named and in a clean and tidy condition. Hats in disrepair should be replaced before students return.
- Hats should be brought to school on a daily basis. The College will inform students if they are not to be worn due to wet weather.



- Please check the condition and size of your child's TCC spray jacket or jumper. Ensure they have one that fits before it gets cold. Students must wear the correct uniform. Alternative attire will not be accepted.
- Please ensure that your child/children have a TCC school bag in good order for use as their primary bag. This is not negotiable and must be used daily. Using laptop cases for equipment and books is not acceptable.

Changes to Circumstances

- If you have had any changes to your family circumstances, or something of a significant nature has occurred over the Easter Holidays, please give your child's House Dean a phone call or send an email. We don't always have to discuss these matters with the students, but knowing if something has changed for your child over the holidays can often help in managing the return to school routine.
