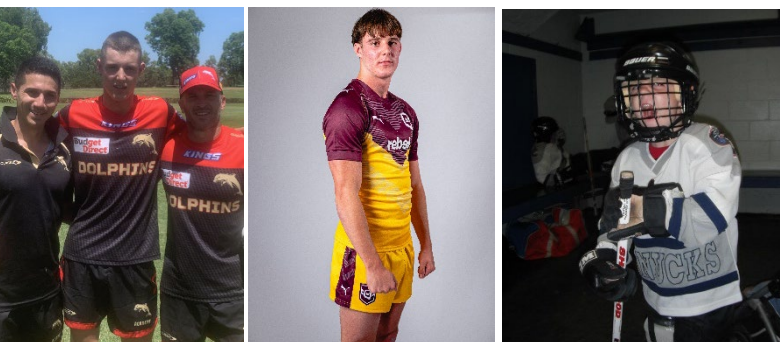

Set to Shine for Queensland

Yr 12 Eli Mc has been labelled **Rising Rugby Star Set to Shine for Queensland U18s** after a week away at State Championships in the Gold Coast, Eli captured the attention of the Rugby League community with his remarkable talent landing him a spot representing Queensland in the under-18 State of Origin match against New South Wales in July.

Eli's Dad wrote: "Eli developed an early passion for sport, initially playing ice hockey in Canada, He then returned to Australia, where his dream of playing rugby league began to take shape. However, his father's career in the tourism industry meant the family moved frequently, from North Queensland to Western Australia, limiting McKay's opportunities to play rugby league. It wasn't until the family settled in Agnes Water when McKay was 13, and a few years later when he started boarding school at The Cathedral College (TCC) in Rockhampton, that he finally got his chance to play rugby league during his first year at TCC at age 15, McKay's exceptional skills became evident, leading to his first NRL contract with the Dolphins at just 15" (Photos provided by Stuart)
