End of Term Notices

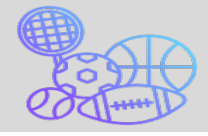

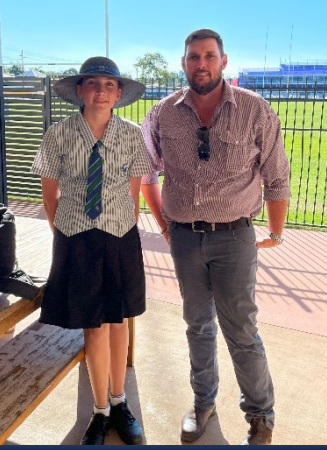
