In addition, the result of the Religion subject studied, must match the student's results of similar Humanities and English subject results. These GPAs are based on the following minimum grades using the A+ to Egrading system.

Grades of A+ to E- are given numeric values in order to calculate the GPA. For example, a Year 10 student who achieved the following results; 2A, 3A-, 1B+, 1C for 7 subjects would have a GPA = (28+39+12+8)/7 = 12.43. The Year 10 student would receive a **Silver Award**.
