ABOUT US

AMEB QLD (PRACTICAL EXAMS IN QUEENSLAND)

The Australian Music Examinations Board Queensland (AMEB Qld) has been delivering music and later, speech and drama examinations to Queenslanders since 1912.

AMEB Qld is a self-funded business unit of the Department of Education that administers approximately 13,000 quality music and speech and drama examinations annually across the state on behalf of the Minister for Education, Queensland.

The Department of Education engages examiners who are specialists in their field, a practice that is unique to AMEB.

Each year, AMEB Qld offers 26 face-to-face examination sessions across Queensland in the following regions:

- Capricornia
- Northern and Peninsula
- Wide Bay
- Darling Downs
- North Western Queensland and
- South East Queensland.

In addition, enrolments are also received for two Video Repertoire examination AMEB sessions and three Rockschool Video examination sessions. Over 1,100 different syllabus examinations are available for examination every year.

AMEB examinations are regarded as the benchmark for assessments in music and speech and drama in Australia with many subjects offered accredited with the Queensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority (QCAA) for the Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE). AMEB and Rockschool subjects may also be used in school scholarship applications.

Enrollers predominantly enter candidates via the AMEB Qld Shop which is found on the <u>AMEB Qld</u> website.

Candidates and teachers may also benefit from consultancies delivered by experienced AMEB Qld examiners.

The Queensland Advisory Committee (QAC) is appointed by the Minister for Education to provide expertise and specialist advice about the conduct of AMEB examinations within Queensland. QAC membership is comprised of departmental employees and nominees of the peak industry bodies and key stakeholders.

In addition, a quarterly newsletter is published which provides updates and articles on topics of interest for enrollers, candidates and parents.

WHAT DO WE OFFER?

PRACTICAL AMEB MUSIC EXAMINATIONS

Candidates can enrol and be assessed from Preliminary to Diploma levels on a vast array of instruments from the following families:

- Keyboard— for piano from P Plate Piano to Diploma level including Piano for Leisure
- Strings—including violin, viola, cello, double bass, classical guitar and harp
- Woodwind—including recorder, flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon and saxophone, including Saxophone for Leisure
- Orchestral Brass—including horn, trumpet, trombone, bass trombone, tuba and euphonium
- Percussion
- Brass Band—Bb, Eb and C instruments
- Voice—including singing and musical theatre including Singing for Leisure

It is imperative that teachers prepare and enrol their candidates for the correct syllabus examination using the AMEB Manual of Syllabuses.

TYPES OF EXAMS

The Comprehensive Examination

The Comprehensive examination consists of technical work, studies and pieces and, depending on the level and syllabus requirements, aural tests, sight-reading and general knowledge. Technical, aural and sight-reading skills are acquired in a sequential way and candidates gain a theoretical understanding of the works being studied and their historical context.

The Comprehensive syllabus provides a framework for the progressive development of a wide range of musical and technical skills over a series of grades and diplomas from beginner to expert level. List Pieces and Extra List Pieces are carefully selected by experts to suit the needs of students at their particular stage of development and to promote growth in musical understanding and artistry in performance.

An AMEB Comprehensive examination (from Preliminary to Grade 8) typically includes:

- Section I. Technical Work
- Section II. Studies and Pieces
- Section III. Sight Reading, Aural Tests and General Knowledge.

The Piano Syllabus offers both Solo and Collaborative options.

Specific requirements of the Comprehensive examination can be found in the current *Music Manual of Syllabuses*.

Completion of Theory of Music, Musicianship or Music Craft examinations is required for practical examinations from Grade 6 to LMUSA. Please refer to *MoS*.

Grades 6, 7, 8, Certificate of Performance, AMusA and LMusA require a pass standard in either Theory of Music, Musicianship or Music Craft from practical Grade 6 and above. Please see *MoS* requirements for prerequisites.

The Repertoire Examination

Consists of performance pieces only.

The Repertoire examination might suit students whose program for developing technical, aural or sight-reading skills does not align with the requirements of a particular grade in the AMEB Comprehensive syllabus. Candidates are still required to have good technique to successfully complete a Repertoire examination.

Specific requirements of the Repertoire examination can be found in the current *MoS* following the comprehensive requirements.

There is a requirement to pass Theory of Music, Musicianship or Music Craft from practical Grade 6 to Grade 8. Please see MoS requirements for prerequisites.

For Leisure Comprehensive Examinations

AMEB's 'For Leisure' Comprehensive syllabuses are available in piano, saxophone and singing only.

These syllabuses are designed for all ages and explore a variety of musical tastes, interests and popular repertoire from:

- The classics
- Jazz standards
- Arrangements of movie themes
- Popular songs
- Concert arrangements.

Candidates are given the choice between aural tests and sight-reading in the Leisure syllabuses.

There is no additional requirement to pass any grade of Theory of Music, Musicianship or Music Craft.

Specific requirements of the For Leisure Comprehensive examination can be found in the current *Music Manual of Syllabuses*.

For Leisure Repertoire Examinations

The 'For Leisure' (Repertoire) examination is available for piano, saxophone and singing only.

'For Leisure' Repertoire examinations are available for Level 1 and Level 2, up to Grade 8 and candidates present repertoire pieces requirements only.

There is no additional requirement to pass any grade of Theory of Music, Musicianship or Music Craft.

Specific requirements of the For Leisure Repertoire examination can be found in the current *Music Manual of Syllabuses*.

Ensemble Performance Examinations

The Ensemble Performance syllabuses enable ensembles to be examined and focus on works for instruments in the specified family.

Ensemble are examined from Grade 1 to Diploma level.

Ensemble performance syllabuses are available from AMEB Federal Office's website.

P Plate Piano Examinations

Designed for beginners, the AMEB P Plate Piano program is supported by a series of books, an interactive website, online teacher support and the option for student assessments and awards.

P Plate Piano takes beginner pianists on a fun learning journey, introducing a range of musical styles from classical to contemporary and teaches essential techniques.

To build confidence in performing and examinations, students can choose to take a non-graded AMEB assessment on completion of each book. At the end of the assessment, every student is presented with a certificate by the examiner recognising their achievement and a written report is available for the enroller to download from the AMEB Qld Shop in "My Results" tab.

Associate and Licentiate Practical Examinations


Recognised globally, diploma level examinations represent the highest level of attainment and achievement of the AMEB program.

Refer to the *General Requirements* and Level 3 Associate and Licentiate descriptions in the current year's *Manual of Syllabuses* for details.

The AMEB Video Repertoire Examination (VRE)

Candidates can complete either a Repertoire or 'For Leisure' Repertoire examination by video. The video examination may be attractive to candidates from rural and remote areas who may not be able to attend an examination in person.

The VRE syllabus requirements are the same as a face-to-face repertoire examination. To properly prepare your candidates, please refer to the relevant syllabus for the candidate's particular level and grade in the relevant Manual of Syllabuses and <u>video guidelines for recording and uploading</u>.



PRACTICAL SPEECH AND DRAMA EXAMINATIONS

AMEB offers graded practical examinations in Speech and Drama. Candidates can study Voice and Communication, Speech and Performance, Drama and Communication from Preliminary to Diploma levels.

Candidates for Speech and Drama syllabuses may be required to supply their own materials and props for examinations. AMEB Qld can supply some props on request. For further information, please contact enquiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au

For the full requirements of a particular syllabus, please refer to the relevant subject level in the *Manual of Syllabuses*.

Speech Pre-examinations

Speech Pre-examinations are also available for young, inexperienced or enthusiastic students who want to experience an examination but do not yet have the requisite maturity and skills. The Pre-exam offers candidates the opportunity to experience the examination situation in an enjoyable and non-graded environment.

The Pre-exam is available individually or in a small group (2–3 people).

Speech and Performance

Speech and Performance examinations are designed to develop interpretative and performance skills across a broad spectrum of styles, genres and eras, and are offered from Preliminary to Licentiate Diploma level. Candidates will:

- secure vocal technique
- achieve integrated physical response, imaginative and insightful presentation of texts
- develop the skills required for interpreting to audiences in a variety of performance spaces.

Drama and Communication

Drama and Communication examinations offer a series of examinations in the area of performing arts. The examinations are especially designed for a wide range of drama and speech learning environments and provide for creative flexibility within these contexts. The syllabus should appeal to both classroom Drama teachers and Speech and Drama teachers working in a private studio.

It is a multi-optional syllabus and candidates may present for examination:

- in one large class group in which sub-groups could work together to flesh out the focus and performance for the chosen grade—these students would present one examination lasting 30 minutes (or more according to level)
- in pairs (duo)
- as individual candidates.

Voice and Communication

Voice and Communication examinations are designed to develop voice and communication skills for everyday life and career opportunities. Examinations are offered from Preliminary Grade to Associate Diploma. The examinations are designed to develop confidence in communications, including:

- the skills to read effectively
- speak with clarity
- make presentations to a variety of audiences.

ROCKSCHOOL MUSIC EXAMINATIONS



ONLINE AMEB THEORY GRADE EXAMINATIONS (SCORE)



AMEB offers graded online examinations covering the theoretical aspects of music.

When an online theory examination is purchased via <u>SCORE</u>, the candidate will be issued with an Exam Key and Exam PIN, unique codes which, together, give access to practice and official exams. Please note, the Exam Key expires twelve months after purchase. Extensions of 30 days may be purchased through the Online Learning and <u>Exam website</u>.

Theory of Music - Grade 1 to Grade 6

Focuses on the creative aspects of Music Theory and has no aural component.

Music Craft - Preliminary to Grade 6

- Includes both written and aural components throughout the syllabus.
- Grade 5 and 6 available in paper-based format on application through AMEB Ltd (Federal Office).
- Provides an alternative way of teaching theoretical and aural aspects of music in each grade.

Musicianship - Grade 1 to Grade 6

- Examinations introduce an aural component from Grade 4.
- The syllabuses for Theory of Music and Musicianship are similar from Preliminary to Grade 4.

Student workbooks are available to assist candidates in preparing for their examinations from the AMEB Qld Shop. Teacher guides for Music Craft are also available.

Speech and Performance Theory

This syllabus provides candidates with the opportunity to show their understanding of the functional framework of speech and performance by focusing on progressive knowledge relating to dramatic performance, oral interpretation and spoken interaction in a variety of communication situations. WRITTEN DIPLOMA EXAMINATIONS (AMEB Qld)

Theory of Music

Musicianship

Speech and Drama

All ASPA and LSPA diploma candidates are able to enrol six weeks in advance of their Section II written examination. The examination date, venue and supervision arrangements are negotiable and need to be agreed between the enroller and the State Office. Please contact enquiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au

LSPA Dissertation

All LSPA candidates are able to enrol for Section III at a time of their choice and are required to submit their Dissertation within six weeks of enrolling. This does not vary the requirement to have the dissertation topic approved by the AMEB prior to commencement of the dissertation.

The Dissertation and any supportive evidence may be submitted in either digital or hard-copy format. For further submission details, contact the AMEB Qld office to enrol at enquiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au

Voice and Communication: APCA Folio

All APCA candidates are able to enrol for Part Two: Written at a time of their choice and are required to submit their folio within six weeks of enrolling. This does not vary the requirement to have the folio topic approved by the AMEB prior to commencement of the folio.

The folio may be submitted in either digital or hard-copy format. For further submission details, please see the Voice and Communication syllabus and contact the AMEB Qld office at enquiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au to enrol.

The *Manual of Syllabuses* outlines the requirements for taking all Grade and Diploma level examinations including, the syllabus objectives, repertoire options, technical work and additional requirements for music syllabuses and examination requirements for Speech and Drama syllabuses.

All AMEB Qld examiners assess examination performances they hear and see on the day against the Regulations, Grading Descriptors and Syllabus Objectives for the grade and level, as outlined in the relevant year's *Manual of Syllabuses*.

It is imperative that candidates are prepared according to the most recent Manual of Syllabus.

AMEB OLD POLICIES

AMEB Qld accepts enrolments on the understanding that the enroller has read and agreed to their responsibilities as enrollers and has read, agreed and accepted all AMEB Qld policies.

ENROLMENTS AND HOW TO ENROL

AMEB Qld accepts online enrolments in all practical exams from all Queensland residents and specific Northern NSW enrollers submitted via the <u>AMEB Qld Shop</u>.

Other interstate candidates wishing to complete an AMEB examination in Queensland must seek permission from their home state before manually enrolling with AMEB Qld.

Interstate candidates are responsible for all expenses incurred to attend the examination in Queensland including flights, accommodation and travel expenses.

ENROLLER ID NUMBERS

All enrollers must have an AMEB Qld Enroller ID Number.

All enrollers must register in the AMEB Qld shop to be issued with a unique ID number which is used for all enrolments.

An enroller who enters a candidate on behalf of a school and is also a private music teacher must have two separate and unique enroller ID numbers to differentiate and manage their private students from their school students.

ONLINE PRACTICAL EXAMINATION ENROLMENTS

Online enrolments must be submitted via the AMEB Qld Shop.

MANUAL PRACTICAL EXAMINATION ENROLMENTS

AMEB Qld only accepts manual enrolments under the following conditions:

- If the enroller does not have internet access to the online shop.
- The candidate lives interstate and has been approved to complete the exam in Queensland.
- For F.Mus.A, written Diploma and teaching exam candidates.
- Ensembles.

CANDIDATE NAMES AND GENDER

Similar to State Schools, children must be enrolled under their legal name and gender as it appears on their birth certificate.

PREFERRED NAME

The candidate's parent/enroller may additionally nominate for a preferred first name to be recorded and used on the candidate slip and report.

Please note the certificate will display the candidate's legal name e.g., (First, Middle – if provided-and Last name).

DATES TO AVOID

- You must provide dates to avoid (if any) upon enrolment in the space provided.
- Only <u>reasonable</u> requests for dates to avoid will be considered but are not guaranteed for:
 - Religious observance
 - Sporting fixtures
 - School examinations, camps or special events including SHEP and eisteddfodau

o Family events including weddings etc.

Requests for specific examination dates and times, including at the end of an examination session, or to accommodate accompanists are not accepted.

INDIVIDUAL NEEDS

- AMEB Qld will make reasonable adjustments for candidates' individual needs where appropriately identified upon enrolment.
- An enroller must advise AMEB Qld of the candidate's individual needs in writing when enrolling and notify as soon as possible after enrolment if a condition worsens.
- Medical documentation of the candidate's diagnosis must be provided to AMEB Qld on enrolment.
- To ensure we have up-to-date information, identification of individual needs must be submitted with every enrolment. The only exception to this rule is where the candidate's needs are not likely to change from one exam year to another in which case providing the original medical documentation will suffice for each enrolment. AMEB Qld does not retain personal information on file.
- At the time of enrolment, the enroller must tick the relevant consent box on the enrolment form to confirm they give permission for the candidate's medical information and individual needs to be provided to relevant AMEB Qld staff including examiners.
- While AMEB Qld provides candidates with reasonable adjustments tailored to meet their individual needs, all candidates will be assessed against the national standards published in the Manual of Syllabuses.

SPECIAL REQUESTS

Special requests must be made on enrolment.

Special requests are:

- Multiple candidates to be examined on the same day.
- Travel considerations for candidates from regional or border towns to an exam centre.
- To advise if there is a conflict of interest with a particular examiner, see conflict and examiner exclusion policy.
- Requests for preferred examiners are NOT accepted
- Requests to exclude examiners other than for conflict of interest reasons is also not accepted.

PAYMENT OF ENROLMENT FEES

All fees must be paid before an enrolment is processed.

Payments must be made:

- online via AMEB Qld Shop website by 11.59pm on the session close date
- manual enrolments via BPoint by 4pm on the session close date or
- in person, at AMEB Qld, by 4pm on the close date
- AMEB Qld cannot accept credit card payments by phone or email.

Note: all transactions involving AMEB Qld will appear on your bank statement as 'Queensland Government 2' or 'Qld Gov 2'.

LATE FEES

Late enrolments are allowed up to 14 days after the close date.

- Late enrolments can still be made online via the AMEB Qld Shop.
- Or by manual enrolment form.
- A <u>late fee</u> per candidate will be applied automatically to the online enrolment and must also be paid with a manual enrolment.

No late enrolments will be accepted for Video Repertoire and Rockschool Video examinations.

After the conclusion of the late fee period, enrolments cannot be made via the AMEB Qld Shop.


WAITLIST FEES

After the late fee period concludes, candidates may apply to be waitlisted for an examination.

- Wait list applications must be made via email at enquiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au.
- The State Manager has the discretion to accept wait list applications subject to the availability of a suitable examiner and venue.
- A wait list application form must be completed and submitted to payments.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au for the State Manager's consideration.
- If accepted, a BPoint link will be emailed to the enroller for full payment of the original examination fee plus a <u>waitlist fee</u> per candidate.
- If AMEB Qld is unable to honour the waitlisted enrolment, the enrolment fee will be refunded in full. AMEB Qld will retain the waitlist fee to cover administration costs.

CONFIRMATION OF ENROLMENT

Enrollers and payees will receive confirmation of enrolment and tax invoice to their registered email address after full payment has been received.

ENROLLING IN TEACHING QUALIFICATIONS

Teacher Diploma practical examinations are held at the AMEB Qld Studios in Ashgrove. Enrolment must be made manually. Contact the AMEB Qld office at enquiries.ameb@ged.gld.gov.au to enrol.

ENROLLING IN THE FMUSA

FMUSA examinations are held at the AMEB Qld Studios in Ashgrove. Enrolment must be made manually. Contact the AMEB Qld office at enguiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au to enrol.

ENROLLING IN CONSULTANCIES

Enrolment must be made manually. Contact the AMEB Qld office at enquiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au to enrol.

ENROLLING IN ROCKSCHOOL THEORY

Popular Music Theory and Music Production Exams are administered by the <u>AMEB Ltd Office - SCORE</u>

EXAM SCHEDULING, EXAM ADVICES AND CANDIDATE SLIPS

Candidates must be exam ready on the first day of the enrolled session.

AMEB Old schedules all examinations based on:

- examiner availability
- venue availability
- individual needs
- dates to avoid
- identified, relevant conflicts of interest
- reasonable special requests.

AMEB Qld aims to release all examination advices, including candidate slips to enrollers **three weeks before the examination date**.

The enroller will receive a link via email to the AMEB Qld Shop where they will locate the updated information in their "My Records" tab.

The enroller must provide all examination advice to the candidate's parent as soon as possible to ensure the parent and candidate are aware of the date, time and location of their exam. If an enroller has not received the candidate exam information before the start of examination session, they are to email AMEB Qld at enquiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au



Stage 1:

An enroller enrols candidate before the session close date. Enrollers must inform AMEB Qld of all dates to be avoided, individual needs and other special requests.

Stage 2:

The scheduling team commence timetabling examinations immediately after the closing date for each session.

Stage 3

The scheduling process can take up to five weeks to finalise. Schedulers match demand for instrument groups to the availability of examiners, and venues while taking into account enrolment requests.

Stage 4

Schedulers endeavour to release examination advice (date, time and location) and the candidate slips to enrollers three weeks prior to the examination date. The enroller will receive an email, directing them to the advice in 'My Records' and are required to provide this information to parents.

ENROLMENT AMENDMENTS

CHANGING YOUR ENROLMENT

Changes to enrolment include changes of:

- Enroller
- Subject code and subject name
- Grade.

Before close date - an enrolment will be changed, free of charge, if a <u>Change of Enrolment form</u> is received **before 4pm on the close date**.

After close date - any enrolment errors detected after <u>4pm</u> on the close date will incur a <u>Change of Enrolment fee</u>. A completed <u>Change of Enrolment Form</u> must be received by AMEB Qld at least **three working days before** the **exam date**. AMEB Qld will issue a BPoint link via email and payment of the <u>fee</u> must be made within <u>24hrs</u> of receiving the BPoint link. The change of enrolment **will not be made** if payment is **not received** within <u>24hrs</u>.

When an enroller changes an enrolment, AMEB Qld will email the registered enroller with a link to the AMEB Qld Shop confirming the new enrolment details. The enroller must check the change of enrolment in their 'My Records' tab.

Enrolment changes to correct errors cannot be made on or after examination date.

CANDIDATE NAME CHANGE

Enrollers may seek to change a candidate's legal name where an error has occurred or the candidate has changed their legal name.

AMEB Qld is required to sight the legal documents supporting the change. Acceptable legal documents include:

- Change of Name Certificate issued by Births, Deaths and Marriages or
- A re-issued birth certificate with the new legal name or
- Centrelink or Medicare details or
- Passport.

AMEB Qld is prohibited from keeping any candidate's identity documents on file. Documents must be presented in person at the AMEB Qld state office or virtually via video call.

Before close date - AMEB Qld will change a candidate name, free of charge, if a <u>Change of Candidate</u> <u>Detail Form</u> is received <u>before 4pm on the close date</u>.

After close date - A completed <u>Change of Candidate Detail Form</u> must be submitted to AMEB Qld along with payment of <u>Change of Candidate Detail fee</u> at least **3 business days before** the **exam date**. Payment must be finalised within **24hrs** of receiving the Bpoint link. If payment is not received within 24hrs, the change of candidate details will not be made.

ENROLMENT TRANSFERS

A transfer fee will apply to changes of examination date and time. A transfer may be for medical or non-medical reasons.

Either a <u>Medical</u> or <u>Non-medical Transfer Request Form</u> must be completed and payment made of the relevant transfer fee.

The availability of a substitute examination time is not guaranteed and acceptance of the request to transfer will be subject to the availability of an examiner and suitable facilities/venue.

If it is not possible to transfer the examination, the transfer fee will be refunded to the payee.

In regional areas, a transfer of an examination will only be available during the relevant examination session or the next examination session within the same calendar year.

A candidate cannot transfer from one calendar year to the next under any circumstance.

MEDICAL TRANSFER (50% OF EXAMINATION FEE)

When it becomes apparent an examination cannot proceed due to illness or injury before the scheduled examination or on the scheduled examination day, the enroller must advise AMEB Qld as soon as possible via telephone and follow-up with email confirmation.

The enroller must provide a medical certificate to confirm the illness or injury within 14 business days of the scheduled examination.

- The candidate will be offered the opportunity, subject to availability, to reschedule the examination to a later date within the same calendar year.
- A <u>transfer fee</u> of 50% of the original examination cost applies to this request.

NON-MEDICAL TRANSFER (75% OF EXAMINATION FEE)

A transfer for any other reason is a non-medical transfer.

- A fee of 75% of the original enrolment fee applies to this request.
- Transfer forms must be returned within 14 days of the request being made.
- Failure to return the form in this timeframe will result in the forfeiture of the enrolment fee.

REFUNDS

WITHDRAWAL BEFORE CLOSE DATE

An enroller who requests to withdraw a candidate before the session close date must advise AMEB Qld in writing by emailing enquiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au. Upon approval of the request, AMEB Qld will email a Refund Form to be completed by the enroller and submitted to payments.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au. AMEB Qld will then refund the examination fee, less an administration fee. Refunds will only be made within the calendar year.

WITHDRAWAL AFTER CLOSE DATE

Candidates withdrawing for non-medical reasons after the close date will not receive any refund unless extenuating circumstances exist.

Applications to withdraw from an examination for extenuating circumstances must be made in writing to the State Manager at enquiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au and supporting documentation may be requested. Upon approval, AMEB Qld will refund the enrolment fee less an administration fee. Refunds will only be made within the calendar year.

WITHDRAWAL AFTER CLOSE DATE FOR MEDICAL REASONS

When a candidates' enrolment is cancelled due to injury or illness and the candidate is unable to transfer to another session within the same calendar year, 50% of the examination fee will be refunded to the payee.

Enrollers must advise AMEB Qld of their candidate's withdrawal as soon as possible if an examination is unable to proceed due to illness or injury.

AMEB Qld will email a <u>Medical Refund Form</u> to be completed by the enroller and submitted to payments.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au

Relevant medical documentation to support the refund request must be provided within **14 business** days of the scheduled examination. AMEB Qld will then refund 50% of the examination fee.

AMEB OLD UNABLE TO DELIVER SERVICES

Customers will receive a 100% refund of enrolment fees in the event AMEB Qld cannot facilitate the examination service.

FAILURE TO ATTEND SCHEDULED EXAMINATION ON THE DAY

If a candidate fails to attend their examination at the scheduled time and date, the enrolment fee will be forfeited.

If the examination cannot proceed due to illness or injury suffered on the day, the enroller and/or parent must notify AMEB Qld via telephone and follow-up by email at enquiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au by the next business day to arrange a medical transfer or withdrawal for medical reasons.

FAILURE TO SUBMIT A VIDEO EXAMINATION SUBMISSION

If a candidate fails to submit their video examination at the scheduled time and date, the enrolment fee will be forfeited.

WRITTEN EXAMINATION REFUND

Candidates who withdraw within 14 days from enrolment day may be entitled to a full refund. Candidates withdrawing after this prescribed time will forfeit the enrolment fee.

RECEIVING REFUNDS

- If bank account details are provided on the Request for Refund form the refund will be returned to the nominated bank account.
- If no bank account details are provided a cheque will be forwarded to the enroller.
- If payment is made by BPoint, the payment will be refunded back to the credit card used to purchase the examination/product and
- If the teacher has made the payment and receives a refund, it is the teacher's responsibility to reimburse the refund to the parent, if required.

PRACTICAL EXAMINATION VENUES

Teachers may request that music, Rockschool and speech and drama examinations be conducted at an external venue, such as a private centre, studio or school.

The venue owner or a representative nominated by the venue must complete the <u>Practical</u> <u>examination venue questionnaire (PDF, 448KB)</u> and submit to <u>enquiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au</u> prior to any examinations being held there.

The venue owner or representative must not contact examiners directly regarding scheduling examinations at their venue.

External examination venues are selected based on availability within the nominated session, suitability of examination room facilities and consideration may be given to the venue's proximity to the enroller.

MINIMUM REQUIRED HOURS

External venues must:

- Meet a minimum of three hours of examining in metropolitan Brisbane.
- A minimum of five hours of examining in regional locations.
- Have applied to and been approved by the State Manager to facilitate AMEB examinations at their venue before the examinations are scheduled.

Where there are insufficient candidates to meet the minimum number of examining hours, AMEB Qld may negotiate alternative arrangements with enrollers.

PRE-EXAMINATION PRACTICE SESSIONS

Candidates enrolled and scheduled for examinations are permitted to book the use of an AMEB Qld studio in Ashgrove to practice prior to their examination; however, these are subject to availability. A free one-hour session is available for candidates in Grade 8 and above. Additional one-hour sessions are then available to purchase.

Practice sessions are also available to candidates Grade 7 and below, for an hourly fee.

<u>Fees</u> are payable in person at the time of the practice session by credit card or prior to the practice by B-Point link (email).

Practices may not be on the same day as the examination and may not be available in the scheduled examination room. Please contact the office to schedule a practice time.

GENERAL EXAM AND OTHER POLICIES

EXAM CONDITIONS

AMEB exams are conducted under examination conditions, consequently examiners must assess the candidate for the syllabus and grade for which they are enrolled.

Enrolments cannot be changed on the day.

Mixed syllabuses are not allowed during an examination. For example, a candidate cannot present Old Syllabus technical work and New Syllabus pieces.

An examiner will ask a candidate to complete technical work prescribed in the examination in which they are enrolled.

To avoid interrupting the exam, examiners will hear an incorrect repertoire piece when a candidate presents mixed syllabuses, and provide commentary on the report.

When incorrect works are presented, "Unable to Assess or U/A" will be recorded in the relevant section of the candidate's report.

Relevant penalties apply with an explanation as to the penalty provided in the General Remarks section.

ARRIVING BEFORE THE EXAMINATION

Candidates should arrive at least 10 minutes prior to the examination start time and must be ready to start their examination at the scheduled time.

EXAMINATION DAY WARM-UP

Warm up rooms are not guaranteed at any venue. Warm-up rooms are provided for the purpose of warming-up only. Candidates must not expect a full rehearsal.

Candidates may be provided with an opportunity to warm-up:

- five minutes before a grade examination or
- 15 minutes before a diploma examination, where time permits.

Accompanists or associate artists can attend the warm-up room for purpose of warming up with the candidate.

Teachers and parents are not permitted in the warm-up rooms unless a special request has been submitted at the time of enrolment for:

- Anxious candidates
- First time candidates and
- Particularly young candidates who may require assistance with preparation and/or tuning of instruments.

Candidates sitting examinations in any location are strongly encouraged to make final preparations at home before travelling to the examination venue.

PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION

All candidates undertaking:

- AMEB examinations Grade 8 and above MUST present photographic identification to the AMEB supervisors and
- Rockschool examinations Grade 6 and above MUST present photographic identification to the AMEB supervisors.

Acceptable photo identification documents include:

- School identification card
- University student card
- Passport
- Driver Licence.

If photographic identification is not provided on the day of the examination, candidates are required to bring the identification in person to the AMEB Qld State Office within 48 hours of the examination.

In regional areas, a JP certified copy of the candidate's identification must be emailed to enquiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au within 48 hours of the examination.

Examination results will be withheld if identification is not provided.

GENDER DIVERSITY

AMEB Qld may request documentation to support the candidate identifying differently from their biological sex as recorded on their birth certificate or passport. Documentation could include:

- A statement from a Registered Medical Practitioner or a Registered Psychologist which specifies their gender.
- A valid Australian Government travel document, such as a valid passport, which specifies their gender or
- A state or territory birth certificate, which specifies their gender. A document from a state or territory Registrar of Birth Deaths and Marriages recognising a change of sex and/or gender will also be seen as sufficient evidence.

Under the *Public Records Act 2002* and the *Information Privacy Act 2009* public records such as enrolment details must be made and kept accurate.

Enrollers may enrol a candidate who identifies as gender diverse by recording their sex, as indeterminate/intersex/unspecified in the AMEB Shop. AMEB Qld does not require these documents on enrolment, however may require documents if a change is requested.

NB: The candidate details used with AMEB Qld should be the same as those recorded on the candidate's school documents to ensure their information uploads to the QCAA when required for Queensland Certificate of Education purposes.

CARE AND SUPERVISION OF CANDIDATES

Children and young people under the age of 18 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at the examination venue.

AMEB Qld employees will give direction to candidates attending the venue to facilitate the conduct of examinations or other services.

AMEB QId employees may direct a person to leave the premises at any stage if they are concerned about the safety or wellbeing of the person or others, and/or the proper conduct of AMEB QId examinations.

CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

Enrollers must advise AMEB Qld in the Special Request field on the enrolment form, if:

- the candidate has been taught by an examiner within the last 2 years
- an examiner is a relative of the candidate
- an examiner is a family friend.

AMEB Qld will only exclude a candidate if one or more of these three conflicts of interests exist.

AMEB Qld will not accept enrollers' requests to exclude examiners at any grade or Diploma level.

Previous examination by an examiner regardless of the result, is not considered a conflict of interest.

ACCOMPANIMENT

Except for Extra List pieces, wherever the pieces presented are provided with piano accompaniments, accompaniment is mandatory. Refer to the relevant syllabus for the full requirements.

Enrollers are solely responsible to engage and manage the candidate's accompanist around the candidate's examination date.

Under no circumstance will an examiner accompany a candidate when examining.

It is desirable in all grades for candidates to be competently accompanied. Candidates enrolled in higher grades (particularly when performing pieces for which interpretative success depends upon a musical partnership e.g. sonata, etc.) candidates are advised to seek the services of an experienced accompanist in order to do themselves full justice and be assessed accordingly.

Recorded Accompaniment AMEB to Grade 3

A candidate:

- may perform with AMEB recorded accompaniment where it is available
- using recorded accompaniment is responsible for providing and operating their own equipment
- should practise with the recorded accompaniment before the examination, to achieve the best exam outcome.

AMEB Qld supervisors and examiners will not assist with the operation of any equipment to conduct the performance.

Teachers must consider the candidate's age and technical ability before recommending they use recorded accompaniments.

Where a candidate is performing with recorded accompaniments in an examination, they must use the '100%' or 'performance' tempo.

Rockschool Accompaniment

Examiners will provide the backing tracks for Rockschool grade books. Candidates need only supply backing tracks if performing any Free Choice Pieces which require a backing track. Free Choice Pieces may be performed to a backing track, live accompaniment or as a solo piece (without backing track or accompaniment). If you present a Free Choice Piece with a backing track please ensure your part is not in the recording.

PAGE TURNING, ASSOCIATE ARTISTS AND ACCOMPANISTS

A page-turner may be used by candidates and/or accompanists/associate artists. Page turners, accompanists and associate artists are only permitted in the examination room when required.

MOBILE PHONES

Mobile phones of teachers, candidates and accompanists are not permitted in any examination room, with the exception of using the device for tuning purposes or playing a recorded accompaniment.

USE OF DEVICES

AMEB Music Exams

A candidate should check and test their devices or electronic or digital resources are working as intended and align with AMEB syllabus requirements before the examination.

The speaker/s must be capable of producing an audio quality that is suitable for the type of music being performed and must be able to produce a volume level sufficient to achieve the appropriate balance between solo performance and accompaniment.

The candidate should ensure their speaker is fully charged and bring the power/charging cable as a back-up. AMEB Qld does not provide WiFi services. A candidate will need to use their own mobile data, if required.

Rockschool

Backing tracks for Free Choice pieces is no long mandatory, however if playing a Free Choice Piece with a backing track, candidates must provide a device containing the downloaded audio. This may be any device with a 3.5 mm minijack output e.g. MP3 player, portable CD player, phone or tablet.

Examiners will provide a 3.5mm (minijack) lead to connect the device to a PA system. Audio cannot be live streamed directly from a mobile device as they must be turned off or onto airplane mode during an examination. Examiners will not stream or download any backing tracks on the candidate's behalf.

It is recommended that two different sources are brought to the examination, using one as a backup.

PHOTOCOPIES

In general, the Copyright Act prohibits the use of photocopied music. Photocopies must not be used by candidates in AMEB examinations, unless an exception to copyright applies, or the relevant music publisher has granted permission for the candidate to make a copy.

Candidates are permitted to use photocopies for ease of page turning, however, the original version of the score from which the copy was made, must be in the examination room with the candidate. In some circumstances, a copy of music may be required for use by the examiner. In these cases, if performing from memory, candidates must provide a published edition of the music to the examiner.

Diploma candidates must supply a copy of their music to the examiner.

Examiners may note any improper use of photocopies on the candidate's report.

DOWNLOADED MUSICAL SCORES

A candidate may present for examinations using scores that have been legally purchased and downloaded via online sheet music retailers. Please note the candidate is responsible for ensuring copyright clearance for their use of this material has been obtained. Candidates must note that penalties may apply for the improper use of copyright material.

Candidates may be asked to show proof of purchase of digital downloads. Candidates must therefore bring evidence of proof of purchase to the examination.

RECORDING PRACTICAL EXAMINATIONS NOT ALLOWED

AMEB Qld does not record face-to-face examinations. Candidates, accompanists, parents and teachers are **prohibited** from filming or recording any face-to-face examination.

TRAINEE EXAMINERS

A trainee examiner under the supervision of a senior examiner may conduct none, part or all of the examination. No requests to exclude a trainee examiner will be accepted unless a <u>conflict of interest</u> exists.

NO COMMUNICATION WITH EXAMINERS

Enrollers, parents and teachers are prohibited from directly communicating with examiners on any matter regarding a candidate or any examination schedule. This includes sending letters with the

candidate on examination day or contacting any examiner after the exam day regarding any examination or scheduling matters.

All administration or examination matters **must** be communicated with the AMEB Qld state office before the examination day.

REPORTS AND CERTIFICATES

Reports

Under no circumstances will results be given over the telephone or emailed directly to any party.

- Candidates' reports will be issued to enrollers via the AMEB Shop/My Results within approximately 10 business days after the examination has been conducted.
- AMEB Video Repertoire Exam and Rockschool video reports may take approximately 14 business days after the assessment date to be emailed to enrollers via the AMEB shop.

Certificates

- AMEB Qld practical exam certificates will be posted within 14 business days of the examination provided all additional requirements are met, where relevant.
- Rockschool certificates will be emailed to enrollers as digital e-certificates.
- Rockschool certificates may take up to seven weeks to be dispatched due to Federal Office and RSL UK requirements.

Replacement Certificates

Lost or damaged certificates can be reissued. AMEB Qld must receive a completed <u>Replacement of Certificate Request</u> form accompanied by the payment of the relevant <u>administration fee</u>.

STATEMENTS OF RESULTS

Candidate Statement of Results

Candidates may request a statement of their results. AMEB Qld must receive a completed Statement of Results Form accompanied by the relevant administration fee before issuing the records. Statements will be emailed.

Teacher Statement of Results

A teacher statement of results will only contain the results of candidates enrolled under the teacher's enroller ID.

AMEB Qld must receive a completed <u>Statement of Results Form</u> accompanied by the relevant <u>administration fee</u> before issuing the records. Statements will be emailed.

PREREQUISITES AND COREQUISITES

Candidates completing practical examinations from Grade 6 and above excluding For Leisure syllabuses, are required to complete the relevant additional theory components to receive their AMEB certificate.

To receive their Diploma certificates, candidates' relevant theory requirements must have been completed and marked by AMEB, by 30 November each year.

All candidates must notify AMEB Qld when the additional requirement is completed so that their certificates can be released.

RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING

Candidates who have completed an Australian or New Zealand degree (e.g., Bachelor of Music) or previous study can apply for Recognition of Prior Learning to satisfy the AMEB theory requirements for practical examinations.

Applicants must submit a JP certified copy of their qualifications, including a full academic transcript and certificate to enquiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au

PRIVACY POLICY

AMEB Qld will not divulge any personal information to individuals or organisations without the permission of those concerned, unless required to by law.

Candidate Confidentiality

AMEB QId maintains the privacy of candidate information and will keep details of examination enrolments, examination results and personal information confidential to the enroller for privacy and safety reasons. All communication about candidates and their examinations is with the enroller only. This includes issuance of reports and certificates and any requests to review results and/or complaints.

PRODUCT RETURNS AND REFUNDS POLICY

AMEB Qld is not obliged to provide a refund if you change your mind about your product purchase but we will provide a refund where the goods are returned within 14 days of purchase, unused, in original condition, seal or packaging intact and accompanied by your proof of purchase, excluding examinations.

Items that are faulty, unsafe or do not match their description will be refunded or exchanged where proof of purchase is provided.

Where an item has arrived damaged, mis-bound, faulty or does not meet the consumer guarantees under the Australian Consumer Law, please let us know at enquiries.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au

If the item is no longer wanted or needed, the purchaser must return the item in good order to AMEB Qld to receive a refund. Please include the proof of payment. The purchaser will be advised of the refund less any postage and handling.

If the wrong grade book has been purchased, the purchaser must return the item in good order to AMEB Qld with the original proof of payment. The correct book will then be dispatched.

If there is a difference in price between the two items, a BPoint will be sent and payment is to be made in full before the correct item is dispatched. Please note, there will be a charge for postage and handling.

If AMEB Qld dispatches you an incorrect item, return the item in its original condition and the correct book will be issued. Postage and handling will not be charged.

- six working days or fewer written notice before the event, the total registration costs are payable and no refund applies.

AMEB Qld excludes weekends, public holidays and the event day when calculating how many working days' notice you have provided for cancellation.

You will not be entitled to a refund if you are unable to attend an AMEB Qld event on the day for any reason and you cannot provide a substitute.

COMPLAINTS POLICY

For AMEB Music and Speech and Drama Complaints:

All complaints to AMEB Qld are assessed in accordance with the Department of Education's Customer Complaints framework and procedure.

A complaint about a candidate's result will be assessed on the following grounds:

- If the examiner made a procedural error.
- An apparent discrepancy exists between the examiner's written comments and the result awarded in relation to the published grading descriptors and syllabus objectives.
- Studio facilities had a direct and substantially adverse effect on the candidate's performance. * not relevant to video repertoire exams.

AMEB Qld is not a comparative assessment system consequently, complaints about a candidate's result will **NOT** be assessed on:

- Questioning the grade awarded to the candidate, without any relevant specific grounds based on procedural error or discrepancy between the examiner's written comments in relation to published criteria.
- Questioning the academic judgement of the examiner.
- Comparing the result with that of another candidate.
- Comparing a candidate's results from previous performances, such as school and studio recitals, and eisteddfods etc.

For fairness and equity reasons all video exam submissions are assessed applying the same principles as face-to-face exams. Requests to re-watch the recorded video performance as part of a complaints process or for any other reason will **not** be accepted.

Complainants have certain obligations when making a complaint:

- Understanding that complex complaints can take time to review.
- Informing AMEB Qld of changes affecting the complaint, including telling AMEB Qld when no further action is required.
- Co-operating in a respectful way with AMEB Qld staff, and understanding that unreasonable conduct will not be tolerated.

To submit a complaint about grade practical examinations, please:

- complete a complaint form which can be found on the AMEB Qld website
- be specific, provide a clear idea of the problem and the desired outcome
- provide all relevant information when the complaint is made
- email your concerns, in writing to <u>complaints.ameb@qed.qld.gov.au</u>.

After receiving a complaint, the complaints officer will:

- Summarise and email the complaint and relevant examination materials to the original examiner/s or other staff involved seeking their feedback about the situation.
- The original examiner and/or other staff will provide their response in an email to the complaints officer.
- If the complaint is about a result, the complaints officer will email the Principal Examiner seeking their review against the *Manual of Syllabuses* objectives and grading descriptors.

The Principal Examiner will be provided with the complaint summary, examination material and the original examiner's written response.

AMEB and Rockschool qualifications in music, speech and drama **are not included** in the Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) calculation.


QCAA

Certain AMEB subjects and levels have been recognised by the Queensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority (QCAA) and may contribute towards a student's Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE).

Students in Years 10, 11 and 12 must provide AMEB Qld their Learning Unique Identifier (LUI), their registration date and number, by 31st October each year to ensure eligible results are transferred to the QCAA.

All school leavers must complete their AMEB exams by 31 October each year to ensure their results are uploaded to QCAA on time.

After submitting their LUI number to AMEB Qld, a candidate should check their LUI details to ensure they have been accurately uploaded. For further information and a full list of subjects please visit the QCAA website at gcaa.gld.edu.au



RESPONSIBILTIES OF THE ENROLLER AND TEACHER

WHO IS AN ENROLLER?

- An enroller can be a teacher, parent or guardian, school or a candidate who is 18 years or older.
- An enroller is a person who is registered in the <u>AMEB Qld shop</u> with a unique enroller identity number (ID).
- Enroller ID number is linked to the enroller's contact details only.
- AMEB Qld only corresponds with the registered enroller as their details are the only details held in the AMEB Qld database.
- Dual enrollers an enroller who enters a candidate on behalf of a school who is also a private music teacher must have two separate and unique enroller ID numbers to manage and differentiate their private students from their school students.

ENROLLER RESPONSIBILITIES

Candidate's Enrolment

- Understanding, accepting and complying with AMEB Qld's terms and conditions, policies and procedures.
- Correctly enrolling their candidate in the syllabus subject and grade for which they have been prepared.
- Ensuring the correct name of the candidate is supplied upon enrolment.
- Advising AMEB Qld of any dates to avoid, special requests and individual needs at enrolment.
- Enrolling their candidates by the chosen session close dates.
- Paying all of the enrolment fees and charges, acknowledging that examinations will not be scheduled without AMEB Qld receiving the full payment of all fees.

When a teacher provides their Enroller ID to another person to enrol

If a teacher provides their enroller ID to another person (i.e., a parent) to enrol the candidate on their behalf, the teacher is still responsible for all examination matters and is the primary AMEB Qld contact. The teacher must provide any other person who enrols a candidate on their behalf with the following information:

- Exam subject title
- Exam subject code
- Syllabus type (old, new or revised)
- o Exam grade
- o Examination session number
- o Enrolment Guide for Parents.

Checking the Candidate's Enrolment

- Enrollers must check the details of the enrolment on the tax invoice/purchase confirmation via 'My Records' in the AMEB Qld Shop to ensure there are no errors.
- If an error is detected before 4pm on the close date no change of enrolment or change of name fee will apply. Differences in grades will attract either an additional cost or a refund.
- If the error is not detected until after 4pm on the close date a change of enrolment or change of name form must be completed and a fee will apply.
 - o Differences in grades will attract either an additional cost or a refund.

- When notified by email, download and check examination advice and candidate slips via 'My Records' in the AMEB Qld Shop.
- To amend enrolment errors; complete the Change of Enrolment Form or the Change of Name form as soon as possible. Forms must be received and relevant fees paid to AMEB Qld at least three business days before the examination date.

Distributing candidate examination information

- Enrollers must distribute the candidate slips to all candidates or their parents in a timely manner.
- Enrollers must contact AMEB Qld before the start of the enrolled examination session if they have not received an examination advice.

After the examination, the enroller is responsible for:

 Providing the candidate or their parent with the examination reports accessed via AMEB Shop/My Reports and certificates sent by Australia Post within 21 days of receipt.


Ensuring enrollers details are correct

AMEB Qld communicates only with the enroller. Enrollers must always ensure their contact details are current. Any changes can be made through the AMEB Qld Shop under 'Edit My Profile'.

ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES FOR TEACHERS

- Accept AMEB examinations are conducted strictly in accordance with the syllabus requirements, objectives and regulations as prescribed in the current *Manual of Syllabuses* and AMEB Qld policies.
- Prepare candidates in accordance with the syllabus objectives outlined in the Manual of Syllabus.
- Consider the candidate's age and maturity when selecting a suitable grade and pieces for the candidate.

Teachers who do not wish to enrol and manage a candidate's enrolment should encourage the candidate's parent to become the candidate's enroller in their own right. As a result, the teacher will no longer receive any AMEB correspondence. As the registered enroller, the parent will receive all AMEB Qld examination information, including: tax invoices, examination schedules, candidate slips, reports, results and statements of results via AMEB Shop/My records.



The new syllabus introduces one new examination: Certificate of Performance, which serves both to cap the Level 2 examinations as well as prepare candidates for the requirements of the Level 3 examinations. The technical work requirements have also been reviewed, culminating in the release of *Viola Technical work* (2023). A new series of Viola grade books has been produced for Preliminary to Grade 4, and Recorded accompaniments have been produced for the accompanied works in Series 2, Preliminary to Grade 3. 




